- The Board discussed the relationship between the School District and Fairborn City, along with community outreach. Mr. Uecker shared with the other Board members various services offered by the City Manager. Mr. Wilson also shared with other Board members conversations he had with the City Manager regarding the relationship between the District and the City. Mr. Parks discussed building relationships with other community organization using the District facilities when they are not in use by the District. Mr. Gibbons shared that the District currently has agreements with the City and other community groups for the use of the District's facilities. Mrs. Little and Mr. Wilson discussed getting the word out about Mr. and Mrs. Wilson's matching grant for technology purchases for the District. The Board discussed having the Parent Teacher Organization's involved in community outreach.
- The Board discussed prioritizing a list of programs that have been cut that could possibly be added back. Mrs. Marshall encouraged the Board to wait until the State's budget is approved to make any decisions on adding programs back because of the large variances between the three versions of the budget bill released and its impact on the District's finances.
- The Board discussed the Ohio Facilities Construction Commission's assistance program for building new buildings. Visiting other districts who have already built new buildings
