

NONDISCRIMINATION ON THE BASIS OF DISABILITY
Program Accessibility in all Schools/Facilities

Fairborn City Schools, recognizing that some areas in some schools are inaccessible to individuals with disabilities, adopts the following policy:

All meetings, conferences, programs and activities at any Fairborn City School are available, without discrimination, to individuals with disabilities as defined by the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and/or Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act. Whenever an individual with a disability wishes to attend or participate in a meeting, conference, program or activity which is inaccessible, that meeting, conference, program or activity will be relocated to an accessible area. Forty-eight hour notice of the need for relocation by the individual with a disability should be made to the Superintendent's Office. The Superintendent is responsible for implementing this policy by relocating programs.
