IMPORTANT TESTING INFORMATION FOR FHS PARENTS & STUDENTS

Subject: **Updates to Fairborn High School EOC Testing Schedule and Exam Schedules**

There are four very important assessment periods that occur each year at the high school level: Fall State of Ohio End-of-Course (EOC) Testing, Semester Exams, Spring State of Ohio End-of-Course (EOC) Testing, and Final Exams. The purpose of this letter is to remind you that the timing of these tests for the 2022-2023 school year has been impacted by the Fairborn City Schools master calendar as well as other factors. Please make a note of these very important dates now, in order to prevent conflicts. To help your student plan for success, parents are advised to avoid scheduling family vacations, dental/doctor appointments, and college visits on test days.

Historically, FHS Semester Exams have been scheduled for the last three days of second quarter in December, and Final Exams for underclassmen have been on the last three days of the school year. Senior Final Exams have usually been given the week prior to graduation. **Taking into account the shortened school calendar, the significant number of standardized tests that are already being given, as well as the overlapping of several assessment administration windows, Fairborn High School will NOT be administering Semester nor Final Exams in the 2022-2023 school year.** Without semester or final exams, be advised that final grades will be determined as follows for the 2022-2023 school year:

Semester Classes: The arithmetic average of the **two** quarterly percentage marks; each quarter accounts for 50% of the final grade.

Year-Long Classes: The arithmetic average of the **four** quarterly percentage marks; each quarter accounts for 25% of the final grade.

Final Mark Grading Scale: A = 90-100%, B = 80-89.99%, C = 70-79.99%, D = 60-69.99%, F = 0-59.99%

The Fall EOCs are given only to students who have previously taken the test(s) and still need to meet a minimum score for graduation requirements. The Spring EOCs are given to students who need to take their initial subject tests in English 10, Algebra 1, Geometry, Biology, American Studies, and U.S. Government as well as any students who still need to meet minimum scores for graduation.

Fall EOC Administration: Standard Testing, Dec. 9 - 15 Make-Up Testing, Jan. 3 - 13

Spring EOC Administration: ELA Standard Testing, Apr. 10 - 14 Make-Up Testing, Apr. 17 - 28
All Other Subjects, Apr. 24 - May 3 Make-Up Testing, May 4 - 12

All of these assessments are mandatory, and it is critical that students are here on testing days. More detailed information about the adjusted bell schedule for Spring EOC testing days will be published closer to testing time.
