OhioMeansJobs Readiness	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Demonstrate proficiency in each of the <u>15 identified professional skills</u> • Using the Ohio Means Jobs Readiness form document how you have demonstrated these skills at school, work, or in the community • Have each skill validated by at least one of three mentors
Industry-Recognized Credential	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Earn an approved industry-recognized credential that is aligned to a job considered in demand in this state and its regions. For a current list of Industry-Recognized Credentials by career field look <u>here</u>.
College-Ready	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Earn remediation-free scores on the SAT or ACT <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Currently these scores are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ ACT - 22 on Math & English, 18 on English ■ SAT - 480 on Reading & Writing and 530 on Math ◦ Minimum scores subject to change - check <u>O.D.E.</u> for updates
Military Enlistment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide evidence that a student has enlisted in a branch of the U.S. Armed Forces OR • Participate in an approved JROTC program for a minimum of two years.
Citizenship	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Earn a score of proficient or higher on both the American History and American Government EOC exams OR • Earn a score that is at least equivalent to proficient on the appropriate Advanced Placement (AP) exam OR • Earn a final course grade that is a “B” or higher in appropriate classes taken through the College Credit Plus (CCP) program
Science	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Earn a score of proficient or higher on the Biology EOC exam OR • Earn a score that is at least equivalent to proficient on the appropriate Advanced Placement (AP) exam OR • Earn a final course grade that is a “B” or higher in appropriate classes taken through the College Credit Plus (CCP) program
Honors Diploma	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Earn an honors diploma (see <u>course of study</u> for requirements)
Biliteracy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Meet the <u>requirements and criteria</u>, including proficiency requirements on assessments in a world language and English.
Technology	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Earn a score that is at least equivalent to proficient on an appropriate Advanced Placement or International Baccalaureate exam OR • Earn a final course grade that is equivalent to a “B” or higher in an appropriate class taken through CCP OR • Complete a course offered through the district or school that meets guidelines developed by the Department. (NOTE: Schools are not required to offer a course that meets those guidelines.)
Community Service	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Complete 40 hours of approved community service hours throughout grades 9-12 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Hours must be approved beforehand via the <u>Community Service Experience Agreement Form</u> and documented via the <u>Log of Completed Hours</u>. Both forms must be on file, in addition to completing 40 hours, to earn this seal.
Fine & Performing Arts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Earn 3 Fine Arts credits during grades 9-12 OR • Earn 2 Fine Arts credits during grades 9-12 AND participate in at least 1 community/school-based fine arts performance (separate from the activities or requirements associated with the 2-credits earned)
Student Engagement	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Complete 3 years of meaningful participation (80% attendance) in FHS clubs, organizations, athletics, and/or extracurricular activities as approved by administration or counselors during grades 9-12 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Students must log their hours and have the coach/advisor sign off, verifying participation
