Google Classroom Code: r66hlq2

-All students were confirmed to have Google Classroom access at the start of the 2019-2020 school year. Access was confirmed again during the week prior to the start of remote learning. We reported 100% access with only 5 students that may not always have data to check online. These students were paired with close friends to pass information and informed they can directly reach out to instructors.

-Instructor contact. Major and Sarge can be contacted 24 hours via email. Response time is averaging 1 hour maximum. Cadets and students have access to Maj Fricsons telephone via the class syllabus. So far the process is working very well with zero issues. Assignments will be due, and assigned on Thursdays.

-Google Classroom is the primary resource for remote learning for Fairborn JROTC. Attendance will be taken through the assignment option.

-Remote learning for each week is posted to Google Classroom to include any needed presentations, sample formats, videos, required reading etc.

-Assignment turn in is shared to Maj/Sarge via Google or email. The few students that had minimal internet access are allowed extra time as required and we have direct contact available and used for those students.

-Assignments posted are easy to understand with examples posted. Students are HIGHLY encouraged to complete core class assignments prior to JROTC.

-Fitness and exercise. Part of the JROTC curriculum requirement is Fitness. Cadets will use their integrity to complete weekly fitness on their own. As of this moment we are not requiring reporting of fitness. Use integrity!

-Uniform wear. Uniforms were directed to be turned in for NON returning Cadets the week prior to the start of remote learning. (Most complied, stragglers will be taken care of post-virus).

-Community Service is NOT RECOMMENDED! However we have had some cadets doing service through donations and donations of time. Please report all community service to Sarge/Maj so that it can be logged in the Cadet tracking system. Again it is NOT RECOMMENDED or mandated due to the outbreak.

-Extra contact is available through the Fairborn JROTC Instagram, Facebook, and Fairborn JROTC Booster Club pages.

There are MANY options out there for Cadets, friends, family etc. To gain JROTC information on assignments etc. Cadets please do not panic or become overly concerned about JROTC assignments. You and your families have a lot going on. You are required to do the work and participate in remote learning, however it should be fun and educational, not stressful!
