GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS - CLASS OF 2021 AND BEYOND

Ohio law enacted new, permanent graduation requirements that are available for the classes of 2021 and beyond. The Department is working to update the graduation webpages and will communicate – as soon as possible – the recent changes to Ohio's state testing and graduation requirements, as well as important information for districts regarding requirements for the early identification, intervention and supports for students not on track to satisfy the new requirements.

Class of 2020 Graduation Requirements

As a student who entered grade 9 between July 1, 2016, and June 30, 2017, you have multiple pathways to earn a high school diploma so that you can move on to your next steps in education or a career.

Classes of 2021 and Beyond Graduation Requirements

Current Ohio law requires students in the classes of 2021 and beyond to meet one of the original three pathways to qualify for a high school diploma. As an update, House Bill 491 directs the Department, in consultation with the business community, to present a long-term proposal for graduation requirements for the classes of 2021 and beyond to the General Assembly by April 1, 2019.
