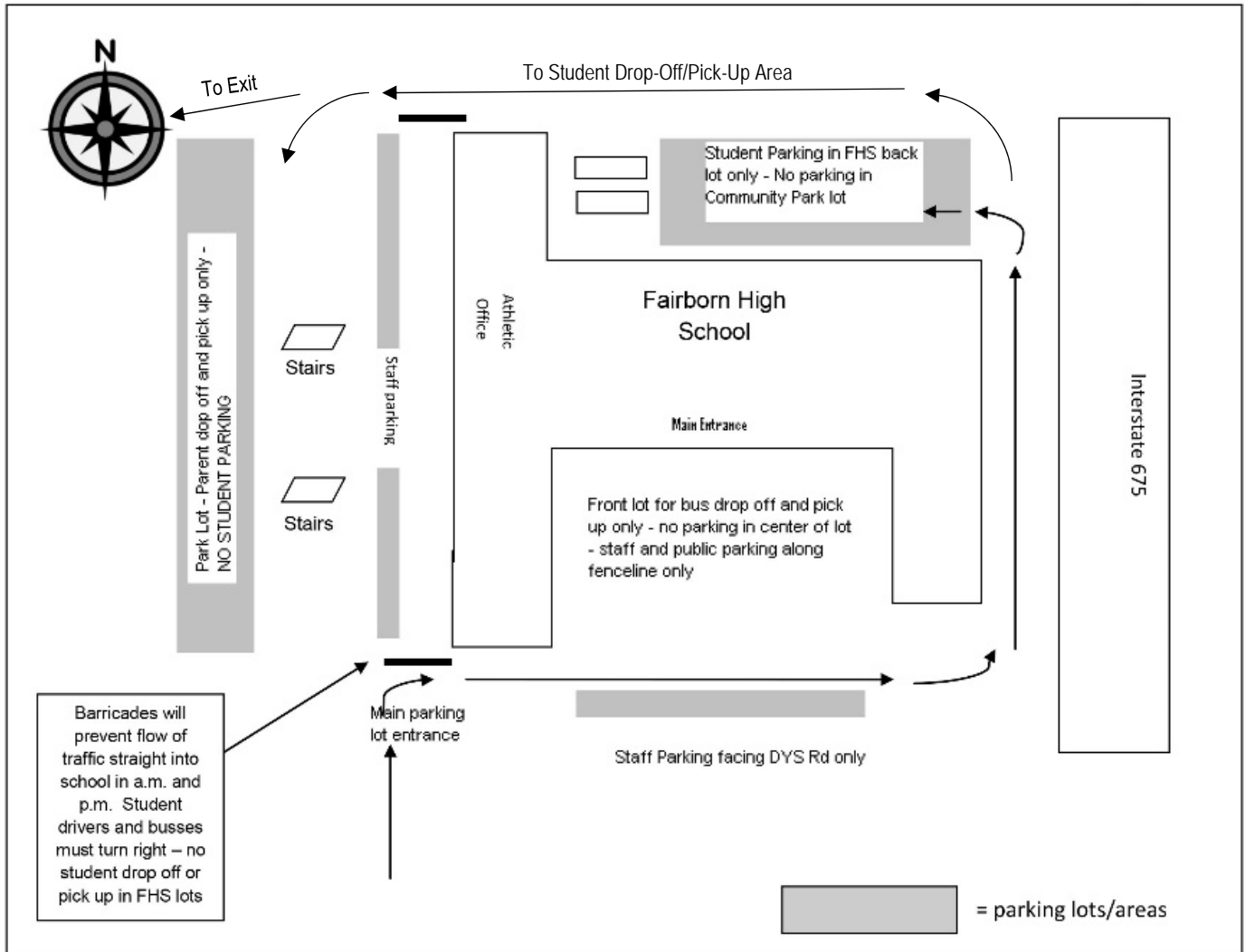


FHS Parking and Traffic Procedures



Student safety is a primary concern, especially in the parking lots before and after school when car and bus traffic is at its highest. To decrease the chance for accidents and to create clear routes for bus loading/unloading, student parking, and parent drop-offs, the following traffic guidelines are to be followed at all times:

- From 6:50 – 7:20 a.m. all incoming school traffic will follow a ONE-WAY pattern counterclockwise around campus. Access to the west drive and west staff parking lot will be denied to allow for students to enter the building from the drop-off area. All standard traffic will exit through the main drive of Community Park; only school busses will be permitted to exit from the front bus lot.
- No student drop-offs are permitted in the access drives nor FHS parking lots before or after school; the only student drop-off/pick-up area is located in the Community Park Lot behind the tennis courts.
- Student drivers must have an FHS parking permit displayed and park in their assigned space during school hours. Students are not permitted to park in the Community Park Lot.
- From 2:05 – 2:45 p.m. access to the main entrance of FHS will be restricted to bus traffic only. Parents and school visitors will need to enter and exit the student pick-up area through the main entrance of Community Park. Student drivers will also exit through Community Park during these times.
- All students, parents, and visitors are expected to obey the Traffic/Parking Attendants on duty.
