

Page 1- (plus one page for explanation)
Cover Design

This will be your design for a new cover for *Romeo and Juliet*. You will include elements that you think are important to the play. It must include 3 visuals or symbols that represent different aspects of the novel, the title and the author. You will be graded on design, color and layout. On a separate page write a paragraph description of the design and why you included what you did as the visual and why you designed it the way you did.

Page 2-
Character Sheet

You will fill out the character sheet on any character you chose from the novel. You should fill in each section. You will need textual support from the book to support your trait. You will not use textual support for the middle area (name). Give the page number and a quote as evidence to support your answer.

Page 3-
Quotes

You are to do the following for four of these six character: Romeo, Juliet, Nurse, Friar Lawrence, Mercutio and Tybalt.

- 1) Find a quote from the book that you think tells us about the character's personality and give the page.
- 2) Explain why you think it is good for that person and what it tells us about that character.
- 3) Find a famous or modern quote that you feel gives us the same message as the one in the book.
- 4) Explain how you think it relates.

Page 4-
Letter

You are to type a letter. You are to compose a letter to one of the characters in the book that will reveal a secret that the character does not know. This knowledge, if the character knew it, could alter events in the novel. It needs to follow a friendly letter format and must be at least 1/2 of a page typed, double spaced. Include specific details.

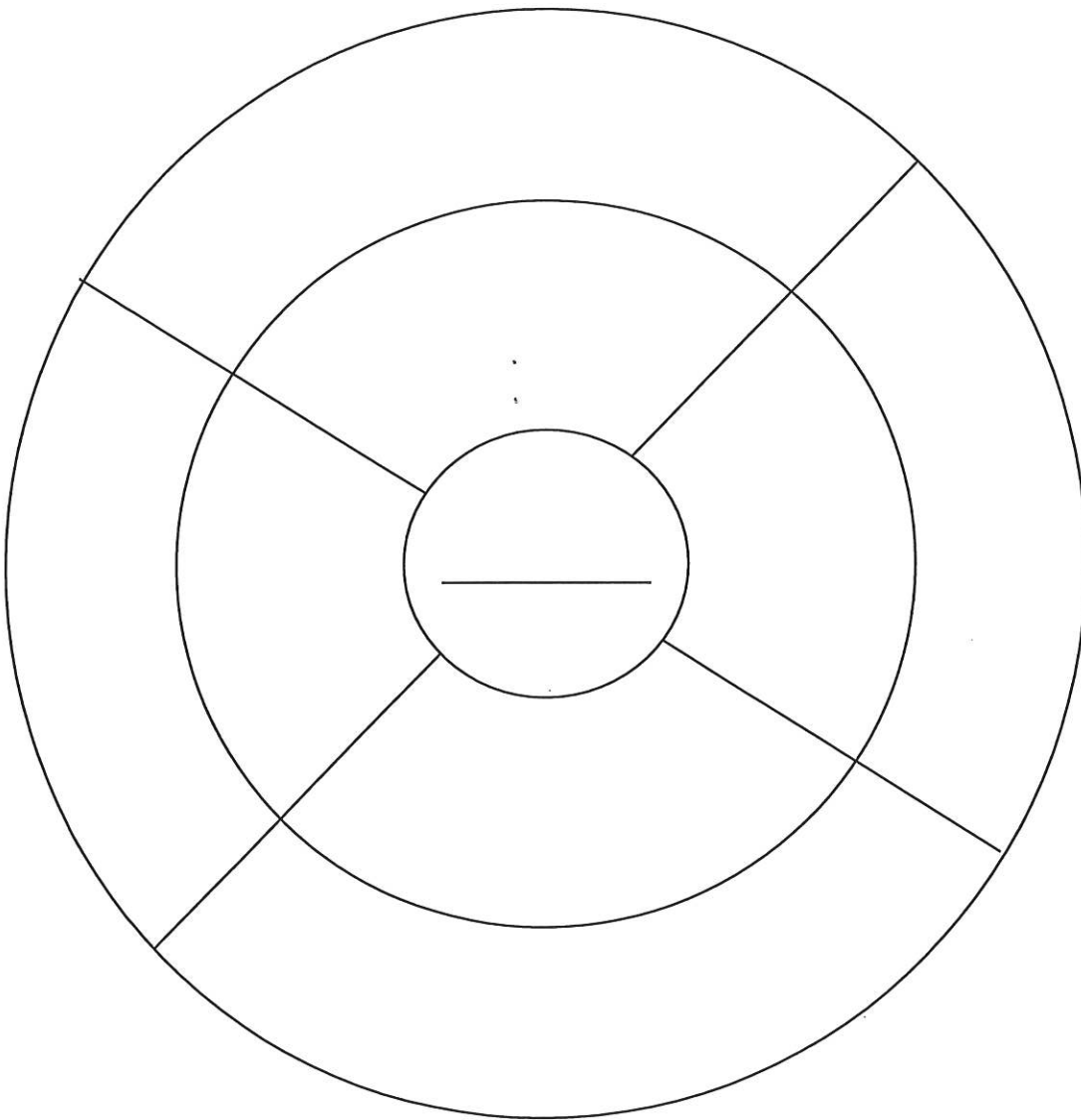
